Year 6 Retreat is booked for summer term with a visit to the Laudato Si Centre at Wardley Hall. The focus is on Transition and stewardship.

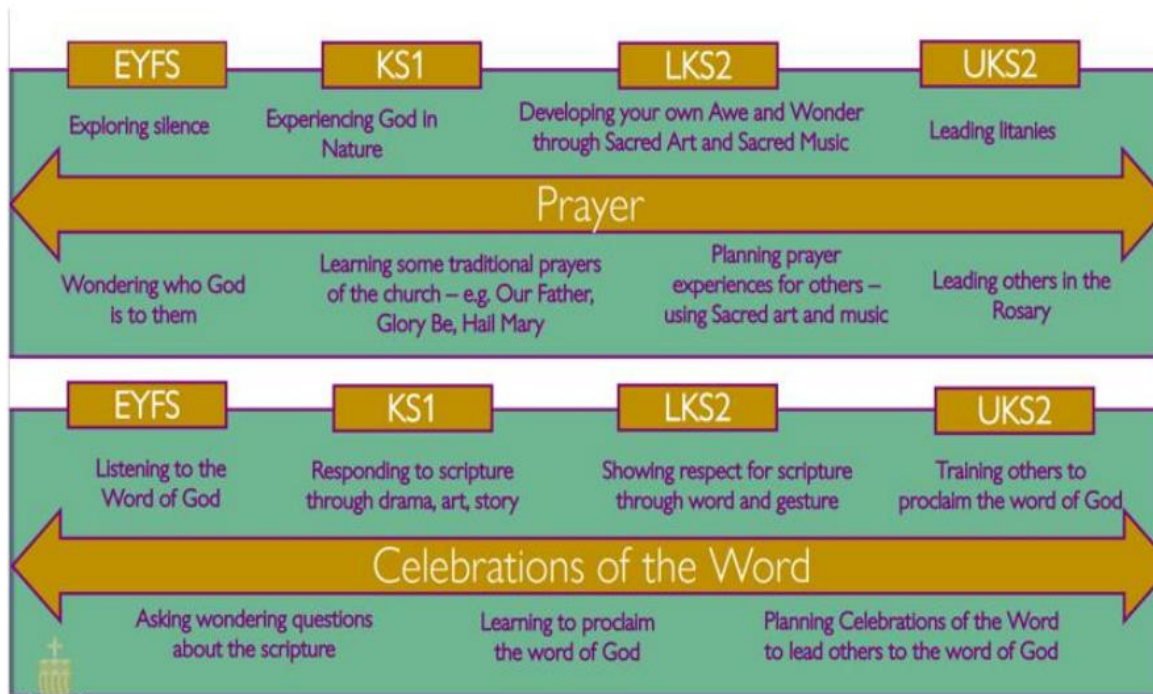
## Common Prayers

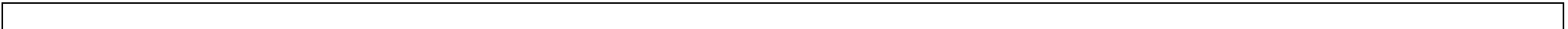
